Thanks to the donations collected during the telethon, an artificial eye surgery was performed for the child Leila Hamdar in Syria. Unfortunately, her health deteriorated after the surgery, but we provided her with the necessary support to help her improve.

**Eleanor Saad** is a resident in a rented house. Her mother does not work to take care of her, Eleanor suffered paralysis as a result of falling from a height and requires at least four physical therapy sessions a week at the hospital, with transportation via a special taxi for wheelchair users, in addition to several costly medications. She needs financial assistance exceeding \$1500 per month. Eleanor may regain the ability to walk again if she is able to continue her treatment consistently

## Yasmina Husseiny

She is bravely continuing her treatment with the full support of her mother, who has been her second eye and greatest source of strength. Yasmina dreams of becoming an artist, creating colorful and vibrant paintings. We have been able to provide her with the funds for her treatment, and she now requires reconstructive surgery on her eye to regain her confidence and move closer to fulfilling her dream of becoming the best artist

## Ongoing Cases

### **Charbel Ziadeh**

Last year, through "Stouh Beirut," we discovered Charbel, a young man suffering from severe autism and morbid obesity, alongside his sister Sally, who struggles with epilepsy and autism. Recognizing their challenges, the association adopted Charbel's case and decided to support his entire family. With the generous donations of kind-hearted individuals, we covered the cost of Charbel's education and rehabilitation at the specialized "Phoenix" institute, at an annual expense of \$12,000. This support has made a significant impact on Charbel's progress, as he has become more interactive and lost over 10 kilograms, marking a notable improvement in his life

Chadi, a young man with special needs, is currently pursuing his studies at NDU. His academic achievements are remarkable, and we take pride in supporting him by trying to cover his tuition fees, but the challenges today are making this very difficult for us to pursue his financial needs. Your support could serve as the catalyst he needs to further excel in his academic journey. Every year Chadi has 2 semesters, each semester is of 12 credits, knowing that this year's cost has augmented, but given his case, the amount was reduced and the cost to be paid is 450\$ per semester

### **Elias Mouawad**

Elias, whose family was featured in a previous “Stouh Beirut” telethon, is navigating health and living challenges. Despite these obstacles, he is pursuing a degree in medicine at USEK, and he is currently in his second year, showcasing remarkable academic competence. “Stouh Beirut” was able to cover his first year of education, but given the high number of medical cases we encountered this year, we will no longer be able to help in this direction, and we believe that your assistance has the power to encourage Elias to overcome his financial challenges and continue thriving in his studies, knowing that the tuition cost is around 3000\$ and the due amount to cover the expenses of this semester is 1600\$



**Hanan Kamel Helal** : 59 years  
She is paralyzed and lives on oxygen.  
She cannot move to adjust the oxygen device or meet her needs. She is at risk of dying at any moment and requires assistance.

## Stouh Beirut Emergency Relief Campaign


On September 24th, Stouh Beirut launched its Emergency Relief Campaign to support displaced families from the South and Bekaa.
