Les Toits de Beyrouth was established on January 4, 2021 under French association law and serves as the sister organization of Stouh Beirut in Lebanon. Created in response to the growing social and economic challenges facing Lebanon, the association is rooted in a strong commitment to solidarity, human dignity, and sustainable development. Based in France, Les Toits de Beyrouth brings together members of the Lebanese diaspora, along with friends and supporters of Lebanon, around a shared purpose: restoring hope to individuals and families who have lost everything. The association works to promote sustainable social, economic, and rural development in Lebanon while actively advocating for the values of peace, social justice, and human dignity.

Through a wide range of charitable initiatives including fundraising events, benefit dinners, and strategic partnerships with socially responsible companies and institutions Les Toits de Beyrouth mobilizes financial and moral support to fund projects implemented on the ground by Stouh Beirut. This close collaboration ensures that resources raised in France translate into direct, meaningful impact for communities in need across Lebanon.

Together, Les Toits de Beyrouth and Stouh Beirut work to rebuild lives and restore stability by supporting vulnerable women, children, and families, offering training opportunities, strengthening livelihoods, and helping communities regain resilience. 

A Memorandum of Understanding was signed between Stouh Beirut association and "Les Toits de Beyrouth" and "Maisons des Femmes Restart" at the Lebanese Embassy in France, aiming to support women, particularly single mothers, as part of the "Femmes du Soleil" project in Dhour Choueir.



The event was opened by Chargé d'Affaires Ziad Taan, who praised the initiative. Journalist Dalia Dagher, President and Founder of Stouh Beirut, highlighted that the center will provide training programs and psychological and economic support to around 30 women annually and 150 beneficiaries per month. Dr. Ghada Hatem-Gantzer, Founder of Maisons des Femmes Restart, emphasized the importance of collaboration to support women in Lebanon. Claudine Haddad Gontier, Secretary General of Les Toits de Beyrouth, and Father Ziad Haddad, Vice President of the association, also spoke about the project's role.

Under the patronage and in the presence of the Minister of Information, Dr. Paul Morcos, Stouh Beirut association launched its new project "Femmes du Soleil" from the Ministry of Information,

this event was with the attendance of officials, media professionals, and supporters of the organization. The project is a shelter and a development center located in Dhour Shweir, aiming to empower women and girls through training, rehabilitation, and psychosocial support. It is carried out in collaboration with the Sisters of the Sacred Hearts and supported by an international expertise from France.

This pioneering initiative, led by journalist Dalia Dagher, seeks to reaffirm the role of women as active partners in society and to emphasize that empowering women is a fundamental pillar of national recovery and the building of a humane Lebanon.

Shadi’s words during the event embodied the true meaning of sustained donor investment, showing how integrated, long-term support can transform lives and open the door to self-reliance and a brighter future.

The clinic will offer Mental & emotional Support tailored to women leading alone including widows, divorced women, and single mothers helping them heal, regain strength, and rebuild their lives safely and with dignity.

In collaboration with Lebanese diaspora associations and coordinated by DEMAC, this campaign is a call to action for anyone who believes in health, dignity, and justice for all women.

Stouh Beirut Visits Minister of Health to Support “Women of the Sun” Project



President and Founder of Stouh Beirut Association, journalist Dalia Dagher, visited the Minister of Public Health Dr. Rakan Nassereddine, in the presence of Dr. Joseph El Helo, Director of Medical Care.

The meeting focused on presenting the association’s new project, “Women of the Sun,” which aims to support women psychologically and medically. Discussions concluded with an agreement to establish a permanent partnership between the Ministry of Health and Stouh Beirut, covering medical and mental health support, as well as awareness and public health campaigns targeting women across Lebanon.

Minister Nassereddine praised the association’s efforts and expressed full readiness, along with Dr. El Helo, to support the project and cooperate on its implementation.

Dagher highlighted the importance of strengthening collaboration between public institutions and civil society to protect women’s health and dignity.

Long-Term Impact: Charbel Ziadeh Thrives with Stouh Beirut's Support



Charbel Ziadeh a young man with Autism Spectrum Disorder from a highly vulnerable family, received critical support from Stouh Beirut Association starting from 2023. The Association ensured his access to specialized education by enrolling him in a private school and providing continuous individualized follow-up. To prevent regression caused by financial hardship, this support was extended into 2025, focusing on developing his cognitive, motor, and communication skills. As a result, Charbel has made significant progress he can now speak, walk independently, express himself through drawing, and better integrate socially and academically. His case highlights Stouh Beirut Association's commitment to sustainable, long-term support for vulnerable children.

From Crisis to Hope: Wajih's Life Saved Through Stouh Beirut's Support



Wajih Baeino was a young child facing a life-threatening brain tumor at a time when his family lacked the financial means to access the necessary medical care. Through the generosity and solidarity of our donors, Stouh Beirut Association successfully mobilized USD 60,000, which was allocated to cover Wajih's treatment at Al Roum Hospital.

Thanks to this support, Wajih received critical medical care that led to a significant improvement in his health and ultimately saved his life. Two years later, we welcomed him back, not as a patient, but as a resilient child who had regained his strength and begun pursuing his dreams.

This story reflects the core of our mission: transforming compassion into tangible impact and hope into lasting change. The telethon campaign played a vital role in amplifying a culture of giving, enabling the wider community to actively participate in creating meaningful, life-saving outcomes.

Humanity Shines: Stouh Beirut's 14-Hour Telethon Unites Lebanon



A sun was born from people's hearts For 14 hours, Lebanon chose giving, unity, and hope. "Stouh Beirut Association" proved once again in telethon 2025 that solidarity has no borders, no sects, no limits. 17 humanitarian cases. One Lebanese heart. And a message stronger than any crisis: humanity still shines.



Yasmina's Story of Survival and Solidarity

Yasmina Husseiny a 9 year old girl diagnosed with a life-threatening brain tumor, urgently needed surgery to save her life and preserve her vision. While she lost sight in one eye, the operation successfully saved vision in the other, preventing total blindness. Stouh Beirut Association played a key role by coordinating support and ensuring funds for her medical care were raised and transparently allocated. Beyond addressing her urgent health needs, the initiative fostered solidarity, empathy, and social responsibility .

This case highlights Stouh Beirut's role as a trusted intermediary, delivering life-saving support while strengthening community engagement and social cohesion.

Stouh Beirut Screens Over 10,452 Women, Detecting 1,000 Cases Early

As part of its commitment to preventive healthcare and women's health, Stouh Beirut Association implemented a large-scale cervical cancer screening initiative across Lebanon. Through this program, the Association successfully provided cervical cancer screening tests to 10,452 women, many of whom had limited or no prior access to preventive medical services

The screenings led to the early detection of cervical cancer in approximately 1,000 women, enabling timely medical referral and intervention. Early diagnosis significantly increases treatment success rates and reduces long-term health complications, making this intervention critical in saving lives and improving health outcomes

This initiative reflects Stouh Beirut Association's strategic focus on prevention rather than crisis response alone, addressing health risks before they become life-threatening. By facilitating access to early screening, the Association played a vital role in reducing barriers to healthcare and strengthening community health resilience across vulnerable populations in Lebanon.



Lifelong Care, Lasting Impact: Community Support Transforms Christina's Life

Christina Eid was born healthy, but a preventable medical error left her with lifelong care needs, placing a heavy emotional and financial burden on her family. SSCC Kfarhabab and Stouh Beirut Association have supported her since 2024, ensuring access to essential care and relief.

This sustained support has not only helped Christina and her family but also created a meaningful social impact, showing how community solidarity and coordinated action can turn compassion into real, life-changing support.




